

# WHAT DOES TRIYOU OFFER?

- **rates for funding** provided by the GPYO for 2024;  
**reimbursement of travel costs** for groups from Eastern
- Partnership countries in the amount of EUR 250 or EUR 350 (for projects in Poland: PLN 800 or PLN 1200) per person, depending on the distance;
- **support for trilateral projects**, including in Eastern Partnership countries.

**The GPYO also supports cooperation with Ukrainian partners, providing for:**

- training sessions for educators,
- job shadowing visits of Ukrainian partners to Poland or Germany,
- small project fund.

## REMEMBER:

- **Support:** funding is provided for travel costs of project participants, from their place of residence to the programme location (transport, insurance, potential visa fees) and back again.
- **Projects in Poland or Germany:** the host country applies for funding to cover programme costs and travel costs of groups from third countries.
- **Projects in Eastern Partnership countries:** The German partner applies for funding to cover the programme costs for all project participants.
- **Deadline: applications** should be submitted no later than 3 months before the project start date and no later than by **15 April 2024** in the case of projects taking place in 2024.
- **Application submission:** applications can be submitted only via the OASE online application platform at [www.dpjw.org/oase](http://www.dpjw.org/oase).
