How to Deal with a Difficult Past? – Educational Perspectives on National Socialism, Shoah and the Second World War

two-part seminar for German and Polish teachers and students

July 18-24, 2024 at the **Buchenwald & Sachsenhausen Memorials** and
October 2-6, 2024 at the **Auschwitz-Birkenau State Museum and Memorial.**

International Centre for Education about Auschwitz and the Holocaust at the Auschwitz-Birkenau State Museum in cooperation with the Buchenwald and Sachsenhausen Museums and Memorials introduces the call for participants for the second edition of the seminar *How to Deal with a Difficult Past? – Educational Perspectives on National Socialism, Shoah and the Second World War.*

The seminar addresses **primary and secondary schools' teachers** as well as **students of master's degree pedagogical or historical studies** from Poland and Germany who in their educational work raise the subject of WWII and the Holocaust. The language of both parts of the seminar is **English** (at least B2 level).

The organizers cover the costs of accommodation, board, local transfers and programme. The participants will have to pay for travel to and from places of the seminar as well as health insurance.

In the seminar can participate 10 persons from Poland (including 5 students and 5 teachers) and 10 persons from Germany (including 5 students and 5 teachers). **Those willing to participate are asked to fill out the application form:** <https://forms.gle/EKBNbt4fRvizyapZ6>
